Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

The Buckingham International Master's Scholarship is for **educational professionals based in Hong Kong** who wish to deliver impact and positive change through postgraduate study.

To apply for this Scholarship the applicant must be:

- based in Hong Kong
- be an eligible candidate for their chosen Master's degree
- be able to start their studies in September 2026.

September/October 2026

You can apply for the Scholarship at any time during the Scholarship application period, but remember to allow yourself enough time to also apply for your chosen Master's course.



How to Apply

Step 1: Choose Your Master's Degree

To be eligible for the scholarship award, **you must apply for a Master's degree** at the Faculty of Education, University of Buckingham.

How to Submit Your Video

Video Requirements

- ✓ Please create a video of between **3-5 minutes** in length.
- ✓ Videos should be in **MP4 format**, with a **maximum file size of 300 MB**.
- ✓ Recommended resolution is **720p or 1080p**.
- ✓ Please ensure your video can be played using standard media players.

Terms & Conditions

- **Scope of the scholarship**

The scholarship covers **50% of the tuition fees for the selected Master's course only**. It does not cover any additional costs associated with applying for or undertaking the programme, including but not limited to accommodation, travel, or other living expenses.

- **Eligibility requirement**

Only applicants who have **applied for and received an offer to study a Master's degree at the University of Buckingham** will be eligible to receive the scholarship.

- **Applicable programmes**

This scholarship applies **only to Master's programmes offered by the Faculty of Education at the University of Buckingham**. Applicants to programmes outside the Faculty of Education or at other universities will not be eligible for the award.

- **Start date**

The scholarship is available **only for students commencing their studies in September 2026**. The scholarship **cannot be deferred** to a later intake.

- **Right to withdraw**

Buckingham International School of Education reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship award if the recipient **does not meet the admission requirements or eligibility criteria** for the chosen Master's programme.

- **Promotional participation**

Scholarship recipients agree to participate in **reasonable promotional activities**, which may include providing quotes, testimonials, or brief interviews about their experience of studying the programme.



Terms & Conditions

- **Final decision:** The **decision of the judging panel is final** and no correspondence or appeals regarding the outcome will be entered into.
- **Application deadline:** All scholarship applications must be submitted **by the stated application deadline**. Applications received after this date may not be considered.
- **Academic standing and enrolment:** The scholarship is awarded on the condition that the recipient **remains enrolled on the approved Master's programme and maintains satisfactory academic standing throughout the course**. The University reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship if the student withdraws from the programme or fails to meet the academic requirements of the course.
